▪ **Tell us about your biggest win from January 1, 2022 through June 1, 2023 and how you achieved the result for your client.**

I was proud to represent Meta, alongside Kellogg Hansen, in the most highly watched antitrust case of the year, in which we defeated the Federal Trade Commission's request for a preliminary injunction to stop Meta from acquiring a small virtual reality studio. The key to our success was our close work with the company's senior-most executives, who were able to explain to the judge the complex world of virtual reality. I found it particularly effective to use trial demonstratives with them to help the court visualize key points, and the court's decision relied heavily on their testimony.

▪ **Share two trial tips that have been key to your success.**

First, be nimble. The most effective trial lawyers know their cases inside and out, and are able to respond to whatever happens in the courtroom, without being wedded to a script or an outline.
